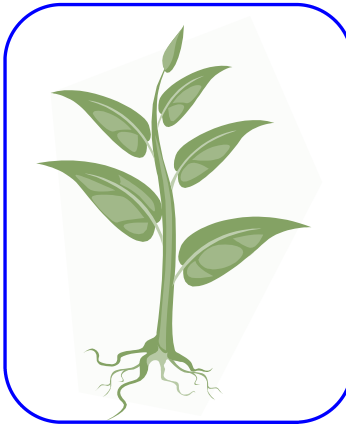
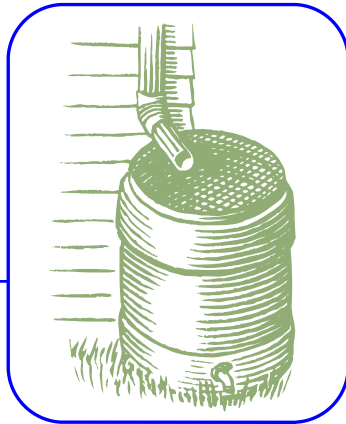


JOIN US FOR WORK(ING)SHOPS
